Background

A: 4 - 13/4" X 3"

B: 4 - 134" X 134"

C: 2 - 33/4" X 33/4"

Brown Center D: 1 – 51/2" X 51/2"

Cut diagonally twice

<u>Leaves</u>

E: 4 - 13/4" X 13/4"

Flower Petals

F: 2 - 3¾" X 3¾"

Cut diagonally twice




G: 4 - 3%" X 3%"

H: 4 - 134" X 134"

Piecing


1. Sew the C quarter square triangles to the F quarter square triangles as shown




2. Cut the Flower Petal G pieces in half diagonally.

3. Sew the C/F pieces created in Step 2 to the G half square triangles as shown




4. Draw a line diagonally on the wrong side of all the Flower Petal H pieces.

5. Sew a Flower Petal H piece to each corner of the Brown Center D piece as shown.



6. Sew the Background B pieces to the Leaf E pieces.

7. Sew the B/E units created in Step 7 to the Background A pieces as shown.



8. Sew all the pieces created together using the Block Diagram as a guide.
